Website Evaluation Basics

Ask these questions to help determine whether or not a website is reliable!

WHO? Who is the person/organization producing the web site? What are their qualifications? *Hint: Look at the URL! Is it a dot-com (.com)? Or dot-edu (.edu)?*

WHAT? What is the nature of the information? Is there an obvious bias? Is it objective? Are they trying to sell you something?

WHEN? When was the website content last updated? Is the information still valid and reliable if it is out-of-date?

Finding Websites

Directories vs. Search Engines

A **Directory** is a listing of *selected* websites. The person or organization responsible for the list has made a determination that the selected websites are the best ones for their purpose. **Librarians' Internet Index** (www.lii.org) is an example of a directory.

A **Search Engine** searches through all the millions of web pages to find those that meet the search criteria. **Google** (www.google.com) is an example of a search engine.

If you can find a directory listing of websites on your topic, you will be one step ahead in evaluating those web pages.
